Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) is offering scholarship slots to international students under Lata Mangeshkar Dance & Music Scholarship Scheme and Atal Bihari Vajpayee General Scholarship Scheme to study in Indian Universities / Institutes for the Academic Year 2023-24. Applications from interested international students for academic year 2023-24 are invited online through A2A Scholarship portal of ICCR <u>http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in</u> which has been operational w.e.f. 12 April 2023.

Opened since 12 April 2023	Opening of ICCR A2A Portal for admissions.
15 May 2023	Last date of submission of application by students.
15 June 2023	Last date for Universities to inform the decision (if confirmed, intimation to Missions; if rejected, intimation to students).
30 June 2023	Last date for allocating scholarship and generating Offer Letters by Indian Mission abroad.
15 July 2023	Last date of acceptance by students.

2. Timeline for admission is as under: -

3. Interested students are advised to visit respective website of University /Institute for checking the courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information about the University/Institute before applying for admission. Applicants have the option to apply for five Universities/Institutes in order of their preference. Candidates should submit relevant all documents as required by the Universities/Institutes in addition to the basic educational certificates mentioned in the application form.

4. Students may be required to obtain the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalence certificate, if necessary. This would be stipulated by the concerned University/Institute in their provisional confirmation letter for the applicant (uploaded on A2APortal). Students should apply for the equivalence certificate at the link https://evaluation.aiu.ac.in/student/login and bear the fees incurred on obtaining the certificate on their own (non-reimbursable). If the University/Institute

requires AIU equivalence certificate from a candidate, it is incumbent upon the selected candidate to procure the equivalence certificate to confirm admission.

5. A 500 word essay in English has been introduced to ascertain English Proficiency of applicants. Besides, students can also submit their TOFEL/ IELTS etc. Standardized Test scores, if available. Universities/Institutes may conduct interview of the candidates online, if required.

6. These scholarship slots include return air ticket in economy class to selected candidates from their respective countries to the place of study in India by the shortest route.

7. Some general guidelines to apply for scholarship are as follow:

- Applicants should have attained a minimum age of 18 years at the time of admission and should not be not more than 30 years of age for undergraduate/ postgraduate courses and not more than 45 years of age for PhD programmes.
- Applicants must be in sound health and should not suffer from any serious illness.
- It is compulsory for all ICCR scholarship students to procure medical insurance policy with a minimum sum assured for Indian Rupees Five Lakhs per annum.
- ICCR advises students to stay in the campus hostel of the Institute, if available. However, students may be allowed to stay in private accommodation if the concerned Institute does not insist on staying in their hostels.
- ICCR may amend some provisions of scholarships from time to time and it is incumbent on students to accept the revised norms.
