You had to learn the conjugation by rote and it was not easy. Therefore, I am very pleased that now the world's first gamified Sanskrit learning app 'Little Guru' has been developed by GamappSportswizz Technologies in collaboration with the Indian Council for Cultural Relations. I would like to congratulate Mr Anuj Sharma, CEO of Little Guru for developing this interactive app which will make learning Sanskrit much easier and more fun!

I would also like to thank ICCR, for this innovative initiative and for offering special discounted rates of subscription to the users of the app. I am told that further details about the subscription, the registration process along with a demo of the Little Guru app will be given by the Little Guru app team after the launch of the app.

I would also like to acknowledge the role of organisations such as Samskrita Bharati that have been quite active in promoting Sanskrit overseas. In UAE alone, around 5000 people of all age groups have benefitted from the efforts, since Samskrit Bharati started conducting free Sanskrit classes in 2008.
